Facilities: - The school has a state-of-the-art infrastructure, and we provide most modern and technologically advanced educational facilities of international quality, sports, swimming, yoga and other co-curricular and health promoting activities for the benefit of the students.

STREAMS: - The different stream combinations for the Higher Secondary are:
SCIENCE STREAM with Physics, Chemistry, Biology & Mathematics & Optional IP, or Computer

COMMERCE STREAM with Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics & Optional IP or Mathematics

HUMANITIES STREAM with Political Science, Economics, Sociology & Psychology.

ENGLISH (CORE) is compulsory for all the stream options.

(As per the CBSE Circular, the instruction came for the Introduction of two levels of Mathematics for All India Secondary School Examination from the Academic Session ending March, 2020 onwards)

In the Academic year 2019-20, the School reopened for Classes UKG and I to XII on 3rd June. The LKG opening ceremony was on 8th June. The School has 2308 students (1138 Boys and 1170 Girls) and 173 staff members on its roll & gives equal importance to the academic and co-curricular activities.

We are profoundly grateful to Mr. Varghese C T, Mrs. Lathika C P, Mr. Raphael K C, Mr. Eldo K P, and Mrs. Aansi Thomas C T who served this institution for long years and are now superannuated.

3. ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE & ACHIEVEMENTS

The Class XII (AISSCE) and Class X (AISSE) results of the Academic Year 2018-19 really proved that the students and teachers chased perfection to catch excellence. They were golden records in the history of Viswajyothi.

Class XII

In Class XII (AISSCE), our School topper SUSAN MARIA MATHEW of Humanity Stream scored 99% marks and got STATE 2nd RANK & NATIONAL 5th RANK. She scored full hundred in Sociology.

Out of the 147 students appeared, 140 passed out with distinction and 7 with high first class. 6 students scored 100/100 in different subjects.

ANNA ANTONY is the Commerce Stream Topper and SEBASTIAN JOSEPH is the Science Stream topper. ANNA ANTONY scored full hundred in Economics, BEN BABY and GRACE THARIAN JACOB scored full hundred in Business Studies, ASHLY JIJU scored full hundred in Economics and Political Science.

16 students got All A1. 61 students scored above 90%.

Class X

The Class X (AISSE) result was glorious with distinguished distinctions. Out of the 146 students appeared, all the 146 passed out with distinction. ALVINA VINOY CHAZHOOR & AGNA SABU were the school toppers with 98.6% marks.

24 students scored full 100 in different subjects. Mathematics 15, Social Science 8 and Science 1.

31 students scored all A1, 110 students, above 90%. Some of our students were Sahodaya Toppers also.

It was a very prestigious and memorable occasion to honour the students for their outstanding performances in the AISSE & AISSCE-2018-19. The School toppers and those who scored full hundred and all A1 were honoured during the investiture ceremony by the Chief Guest Mr. S Surendran, DIG, Thrissur range.

The **TEACHERS** who were behind the scoring of full hundreds in Class X and XII were also honoured.

In the CBSE Interschool Magazine Competition, we got First Prize, in the Central Kerala Sahodaya magazine contest, we got second prize and in the Confederation of Kerala Sahodaya Complexes Magazine contest, we got third prize.

d. We are working hard on our **DOSSIER** to be presented for the hat trick ISA award and the first presentation before the committee scored full marks.

4. HUMAN RESOURCE AND ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES.

In the past academic year, Viswajyothians were involved in many Enrichment activities.

In the Central Kerala Sahodaya Principals' Conference 2019 in the CIAL Convention Centre, the Principal attended and updated himself with the changes. There were Teacher Enrichment Workshops, Orientation Programmes & Effective Parenting Workshops for Parents from KG to Class XII.

- The activities related to the 7 Projects for the ISA British Council award are in progress. For the project ANIMALS IN JEOPARDY, children visited the Zoo, for, MILES AND MILES TO GO, interaction with US students on road rules, for DAZZLING DELIGHT, Chinese lanterns were lighted and released, for NATURE'S CANDY, students visited forest, for "AVON ALIVE", the class IX students made the matchbox version of 37 Shakespearean plays to contain in a fantastic cupboard, for IN

MEMORIUM , interaction with a visitor from France & for BIG BANE, the students presented a street play and visited the flood affected people.

By the end of December, we will be preparing the final DOSSIER to be presented to the British Council.

Students actively participated in the enrichment activities like Social Empowerment Work Education Action (SEWA), Olympiads, and Debates etc. and won prizes.

The inaugurations of **Manorama Vayanakkalari** and **Mathrubhumi Madhura Malayalam** were the steps to enhance the knowledge of current affairs through the medium of our mother tongue.

5. AWARENESS PROGRAMMES & COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH PROGRAMME

Learning from experience has unique significance in the present times. For this, various awareness programmes and health enhancing programmes were conducted.

- g. In connection with the **SEWA** programme about water conservation, the students of **Class XII made posters** and collages with the guidance of their teachers. The posters expressed their noble thoughts and care for the present and future generations.
- h. **"HEART BEATS"- CPR TRAINING PROGRAMME:** On 16 November, 500 of our students (Classes IX-XII) participated in the "Heart Beats", the CPR training programme conducted at CIAL Convention Centre, Nedumbassery.

- In the ‘FRESCO’ conducted by Rajagiri Public School, we got 2nd prize for paper collage and 3rd prize for the English Skit.
- In the “Cliste Kid 2019” conducted in M A International School, Kothamangalam, Aysha Jannath Sheffin (Class 1-A) won Rs. 25000 and a 3 day trip.

OLYMPIADS:

7. HEALTH & PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS

(SPORTS)

The school imparted training in Physical Education, Swimming, Yoga, Athletics, Basketball, Karate, Football, Cricket and Skating by Master trainers in the field. The students participated in various interschool competitions and our school hosted many interschool tournaments.

INTERSCHOOL TOURNAMENTS hosted by our school:

Kerala Sahodaya CBSE Football Competition 2019 (under 14 &19 category) was from 18th to 27th September. It was inaugurated by the Secretary, CKSC, Rev. Fr. Sijan Paul Unnukallel CMI, and in the valedictory, Hon'ble MLA Mr. Roji M John honoured the winners.

CBSE Cluster XI Table Tennis Championship was on 20th September. It was inaugurated by Rev. Fr. Varghese Kachappilly CMI, Principal, Rajagiri Public School and in the valedictory, Dr. Biju Vincent, HOD of Sociology, Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit honoured the winners.

The 17th All Kerala Viswajyothi Interschool Basketball Tournament and the 10th All Kerala CBSE Invitational Cricket Tournament 2019 were from 8th to 11th November. The Basketball tournament was inaugurated by Sri. P J Sebastian, the National Basketball Coach and the cricket Tournament was inaugurated by Anish P Rajan, an eminent player in the World Disability Cricket team. In the valedictory, Smt. M A Gracy, the Municipal Chairperson and Sri. Peter Joseph Njalian, National Powerlifting Champion were the Guests.

The School Annual Sports meet -2019 was inaugurated on 26th October by Mr. Regi Varghese, Motor Vehicle Inspector, Angamaly. Ruby House stood first with 270 points, Emerald, Second with 237points and Sapphire, Third with 202 points.

ACHIEVEMENTS IN INTERSCHOOL SPORTS.

Johan Jenson participated in the 46th **Sub-junior National Championship 2019** held at Cuttack, Orissa.

In the Kids Athletics, conducted at Rajiv Gandhi Indoor Stadium, Kadavanthara, we won Winners trophy in the under 12 boys' category and Runners up in the under 10 girls' category.

We participated in the CBSE Athletic Meet at Maharaja's College grounds from 30th October to 2nd Nov. Adithi Prasad won Bronze in 200 M Race.

In the CKS Athletic Meet held at Adimaly on 7th and 8th November, our team won 3 Gold and 5 Bronze medals.

SWIMMING

The swimming team proved their wonderful swimming spirit by winning medals and trophies in all the competitions, District/State/National levels and in all categories they participated.

i. In the CBSE National Swimming Championship held at Gyan Ganga International Academy, Bhopal from 12th to 16th November 2019 our swimming teams' marvellous achievements make us proud.

The team consisted of 20 participants from our school and from them, 14 Students got medals.

a. In 50 M Freestyle and 100 M Freestyle of Under 11 Girls' Category, Caren Benny won GOLD Medal. CAREN BENNY became the FASTEST FEMALE SWIMMER in her age category.

b. In 4x50 M Medley Relay Under 11 Girls team consisting of Caren Benny, Theresa Shaju, Tiya Bobby, Aleena Jerald, and Devika Praveen won GOLD medal.

c. In 4x100 M Medley Relay & 4x100 M Freestyle Relay Under 17 Girls team of Pavithra Dev, Hannah Roy, Emil Benny and Helen Poly won GOLD Medals.

d. In 4x100 M Medley Relay & 4x100 M Freestyle Relay, Under 17 Boys team of Joe Joseph, Abiram Prasad, George V Jose, Rohan Benny and Jonus K Sathish won BRONZE medals.

ii. In the CBSE South Zone Swimming Championship held at Nehru Smaraka Vidyalaya Bangalore from 26th to 29th September 2019, we are overall runners up. All the 30 students who participated got medals and 20 students out of 30 (boys & girls) were selected for the CBSE National Swimming Championship at Bhopal. **Joseph V Jose (Class VII) is Individual Champion** in under 14 Boys Category.

iii. In the 18th EKM Dist Sub Junior and Junior Swimming Championship held at St Mary's, Thamarachal our team won the runners up trophy.

iv. In the 46th Junior and 36th Sub Junior State Aquatic Championship held at Dr. BR Ambedkar Swimming Complex, Thiruvananthapuram, our team won 15 Gold, 8 Silver and 10 Bronze medals. Caren Benny Class V was the Individual Champion.

Iris Manoj of Class VIII, **Caren Benny** Class V and **Tiya Bobby** of Class V participated in the **46th Junior and 36th Sub Junior National Aquatic Championship** held at Rajkot.

v. In the 12th EKM Dist Senior Swimming Championship held at Rajagiri Swimming Academy, we got overall runners up and Girls category Runners up trophies.

vi. In the 67th Senior State Aquatic Championship held at Thrissur, on 27th and 28th July our team won 1 Gold, 2 Silver and 2 bronze medals. **Arya (VII B) won bronze medal in the 100 m Butterfly Stroke which is a great achievement** because this is the first time in Senior state competitions our student gets an individual medal.

vii. In the 73rd Senior National Aquatic Championship held at Bhopal from 31st August to 4th September, **Iris Manoj of class VIII E** finished 5th. This is the first time an VIII standard student participates in the Senior National Aquatic Championship.

viii. In the RCJPS Swimming Championship held at Rajagiri Christujayanthi Public School, we are Overall Winners with 241 points. We got 20 Gold, 19 Silver, 9 Bronze medals. **Caren Benny of Class V A is the Individual champion.**

ix. In the GPS Super Slam Swimming Competition held at Global Public School, Thiruvaniyur, on 19th Nov out of the 25 CBSE - ICSE schools, we got the Overall Championship Trophy with 134 Points. We got 16 Gold, 12 Silver and 11 Bronze Medals. In Group-I Boys, George V. Jose, in Group-III Boys Joseph V. Jose, in Group-III Girls Iris Manoj and in Group-IV Girls, Caren Benny became the Individual Champions.

JUDO:

Rohith J Nair won gold medal in the under 50 kg under 14 yrs. category in the South Zone CBSE Judo Championship and participated in the National Judo Championship.

8. SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

All the important school events in each month, reached the parents and well-wishers, through the School News Letter “VISWADHWANI”.

As a part of NIE (News Paper in Education) programme, all the Classes from V upwards, are provided with the newspapers in the morning, to develop their reading habits and to update their knowledge in current affairs.

a. Election and Investiture

The School Head Boys and Head Girls of all sections, were nominated by the Management, and the other leaders were elected by the students. The Investiture Ceremony was conducted on 1st July. The Chief Guest was Mr. S Surendran, DIG, Thrissur Range.

b. School Radio: - The school Radio ‘VISWAVANI’s broadcasts of this academic year was inaugurated on 21st June by Mr. Manoj Varghese Parekkattil, the famous film Director (of film Cuban Colony).

c. Expo-2019

EXPO, the Science, Social Science and Mathematics Exhibition was conducted on 29th and 30th of August. Dr. Sonia Sunny, Vice Principal, Prajyothi Nikethan College, Pudukkad was the Chief Guest to inaugurate the exhibition. As a part of the CBSE Hubs of Learning, the students of the member schools presented their exhibits.

d. Book Fair-2019

In the current times, since the social media, internet etc. have reduced the reading habit of people, a book fair conducted in the school from 24th to 26th September by Book Berries, which included novels, short stories, poems, and general essays, general knowledge etc. attracted the children and so many books were bought by them.

e. Reading week-2019: - As a part of the reading week, book reviews were conducted and the best readers were awarded.

f. Field Trips -2019:-

Students of classes I, II, III, and IV went to Silver Storm for their field trip on 8th and 9th November.

Class VIII went to Thiruvananthapuram on 15th. They visited the ISRO, Zoo etc.

Class XII went to Wonder La Water Theme Park on 21st November for the field trip and to Pavizham Rice Mill, Kalady for their Factory visit.

Classes V, VI, VII trips are in January and that of Class XI is in February-2020.

g. SEWA:

As a part of the SEWA Activity, the class X students conducted a campaign for water conservation. They visited the neighbouring families around the school. They distributed a notice to make the people aware about the need of conserving water.

9. ECO-FRIENDLY ACTIVITIES
